Continue with following words and actions: I cover it with soil (pat seed to cover it with soil) The sun starts to shine (widen hand to be sunshine) The rain begins to fall (wiggle hands over see) The tree starts to grow (make hand grow) The leaves begin to form (wiggle fingers on the tree) The tree smiles at me (smile widely




