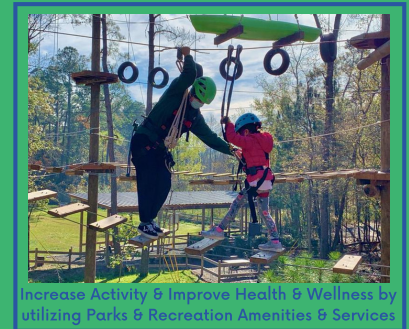
2 Find Your Officials

If you don't know who your elected officials in the Texas House and Texas Senate are, find them by visiting

- <https://wrm.capitol.texas.gov/home>
- Look specifically for "Texas House District" and "Texas Senate District"

3 Set up a Visit

Click on your elected officials names and follow to their contact information. You can call their district office or send an email. You want to request a meeting.



4 Prepare for your visit

5 During your visit

Be polite, appreciative, and succinct. Your highest priorities are:

- Establish a relationship with someone in the office
- Educate staffer/official about TRAPS, parks and recreation, and recreational therapy
- Leave behind contact information in case they have questions in the future and informational materials found on website.



6 After your visit

- Send a thank you email or letter to the person that you met with



7 During Session
