Likewise, an educator who does exceptional work or classroom teaching and also does extension education would be eligible in the areas of instruction and service. Service may be defined as service to professionals or non-professionals who are interested in parks and recreation.

Candidates eligible for this award are faculty members of colleges and universities and are typically engaged in the areas of:

- 1) INSTRUCTION
- 2) RESEARCH
- 3) SERVICE ACTIVITIES
