2. Provide the following information regarding the program:
 - The number of participants
 - The number of spectators
3. Describe the program's use of volunteers and other community resources.

C. EFFICIENCY:

1. Describe how the program made operational, in an efficient manner, the use of money and staff time.
2. Provide the following information regarding the program:
 - The overall budget
 - The total expenditures (direct costs only)
 - The cost per participant
 - The revenue per participant

D. CREATIVITY/ADAPTABILITY:

1. Explain what elements of originality were present in your program. Detail the unique and/or innovative features of the program.
2. Describe how this program was tailored to meet your community's need.
